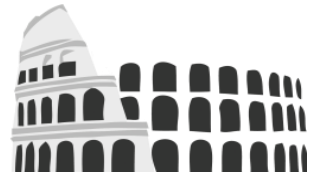

23-24 March 2016 – LSE

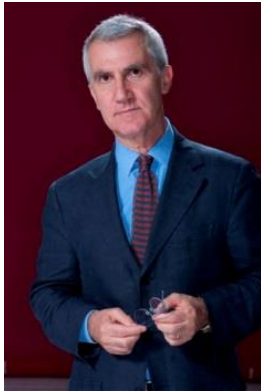
